Report on the annual WA Interclub Boat Angling Championships run on Saturday the 25th of March 2023 at Mandurah

Welcome and thank you for being part of this competition run on the similar format as the ex WA AAA branch, State Boat Angling Championships.

The competition was run with Southeast to North Easterly Winds variable between 10 to 15 knots, with Thunderstorms forecast later in the day, there was a lot of hype since the Demersal closure was on at the same time, but most clubs had already set up their yearly competitions around this date.

We had everything set up ready by 05:00hrs for the start of the sign on at 05:30hrs, with the MOFSC Angling section providing breakfast at cost, and free tea and coffee.

The sign on team once again did a great job, and thanks to all that jumped in and helped (again), some that are always there is, Gamini Jayaweera (QRFC, MDSSC), Kevin Murphy with Roy Lukies (MAAC), Paul Frzop (HYC) with his good mate, Richard Siudak with Justine Coleman (ORFC).

The team all missed John O'Brien for his banter as always, but I did not miss him 😊 as he never stops getting into me.

FYI, John did all the bag tags during the week for you and was sincerely appreciated.

A briefing was had and with the beautiful weather all could not wait to get going, the comp was started at 06:30hrs and all took to the wide blue yonder.

A difficult day to catch the variety of species needed, but an excellent day for fishing, better than mowing lawns!

The boys and girls that did the research certainly benefited in the Mandurah waters.

Most of the teams tried to get smaller fish earlier on; the word was that the fish were on first thing and then the bites dropped off.

The clubs that worked together did well, by calling one another over when they were on to the fish, and this is what is great about this competition, it is not an individual based competition it is team based, and is a pleasure to see the results, and camaraderie.

The wind did not play a big part in the fishing and made it very competitive.

Whilst competitors were "out there" in their favourite spots, Gamini Jayaweera (QRFC/MDSSC) Paul Frzop (HYC), with Henry Boogaard (QRFC), set up the presentation area and the weigh in area, and it looked magnificent, again, especially with the great venue and views from the MOFSC.

At closing time for the bags (3.30pm) most boats had either got their boats on their trailers or were waiting to, with Paul Frzop, Roy Lukies, Henry and yours truly offering to check the fish sizes and types before they went into the cool room, then Roy was given the privilege of shutting the door by our Field Day Officer Paul Lamont (MOFSC)), Roy and Paul ensured that the door was shut at exactly 1530hrs, whilst Paul, continued taking in the skippers safety discs, this was to ensure that all were safely back on land, there was 43 nominated competitors and 22 boats that participated, nearly all actually weighed in, well done.

The weigh in commenced at 4.30pm, in the weigh in area of MOFSC, all the sponsors signage, Backdrop of the MOFSC and flags made for a great spectacle.

The MC for the weigh in was Steve Carter (MOFSC) who provided a running commentary (Secret Squirrel stuff, Steve let me sleep in his houseboat on Friday and Saturday), with a great deal of good humour and light-hearted banter, ensuring that all competitors patronised the many advertisers and sponsors of the event, this all made for a very quick weigh in, and a few laughs!

The weigh in went extremely well again we would be lost without those assisting on the day, and it was great how the Clubs jumped in when they were “dropped in” at the last minute, it goes without saying, we all appreciated your efforts, whilst this was happening, Terry Bell completed the computer work with assistance from runners in the crowd bring the books in for us, thank you.

Whilst all this was happening Paul Frzop was busy selling tickets to the Raffles, and made \$550.00 for the event, with Ticket number **GREEN E 005 Justin Rose MAAC** taking out the First prize valued at \$420, a total of 3 prizes were supplied for the raffle! Second valued at \$400, to **BLUE D060 Justin Rose MAAC** (No it's not a typo, the lucky bugger got 2 prizes), and Third prize valued at \$270.00 to **RED EO44 Jeanette Baldwin MOFSC** (this lady helped the MOFSC with Breakfast coordination and helping the team set up the weigh in area).

The early nomination prize went to **Peter Coleman from QRFC**, valued at \$500.00, and Junior Nomination prize went to **Madeline Close from QRFC**, valued at \$450.00

The presentation was held in the Dining area of MOFSC, and the area was fabulous, and the MC was Henry and myself, who then handed over to our Competition officer Terry Bell and with the banter as always between “rival” clubs, made for an excellent evening, with **Commodore Warren Blay of the MOFSC, Fishing Commodore Paul Lamont (MOFSC)**, Henry Boogaard, Gamini Jayaweera and myself, presenting all the Trophies and Prizes, whilst this was happening, numerous meals and refreshments were provided by the MOFSC, for this we were all appreciative, thank you.

To the **Overall winner and Men's winner Peter Coleman (QRFC)** with 4 species, 1.92kgs of fish and 41.7 points, **Ladies winner Karyn Dore (MDSSC)** with 4 species, 1.63kgs of fish and 40.5 points, **Veterans Winner Steven Carter (MOFSC)** with 3 species, 4.06kgs of fish and 40.2 points and **Junior winner Cloe Blakers (MAAC)** with 3 species, 0.88kgs of fish and 27.5 points.

Gavin Castiglioni won the species being a Leatherjacket (Horseshoe) at 1.075 at 62.90% closest to the state record, a magnificent prize from **APACHE Charters VALUED AT \$3500.00**.

Gary Connolly (QRFC) won the Skippers Participation Prize of a \$500 Being prizes donated by Recfishwest

To all other teams from MDSSC, HYC, QRFC, MAAC, SYC and the MOFSC, thank you all for participating (hope more clubs complete next year).
