The forecast was winds East to North Easterly about 10 knots tending North to Northeasterly 10-15 knots in the morning then decreasing about 10 knots in the late afternoon.

Seas below 1 metre. Swell South westerly 1 to 1.5 metres.

We had 14 anglers, fishing from 5 boats and 1 becho.

12 species caught. The most species were caught Adrian Boogaard with 6 species.

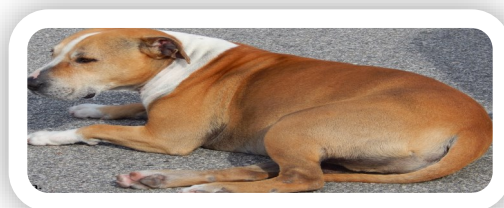

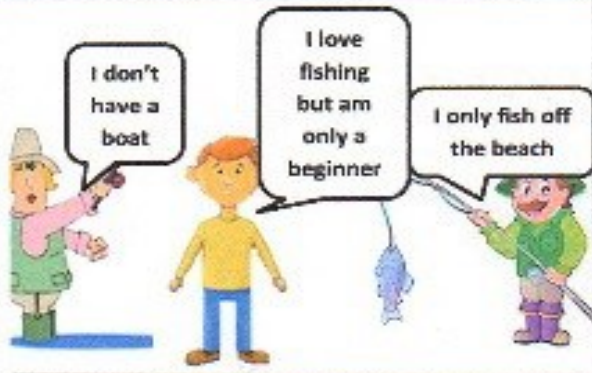
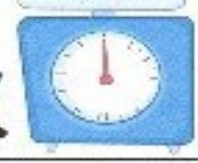

It doesn't matter if you don't own a boat or if you are only a beginner QRFC is for everybody. So whether you like beach fishing or fishing off a boat this club is for you.



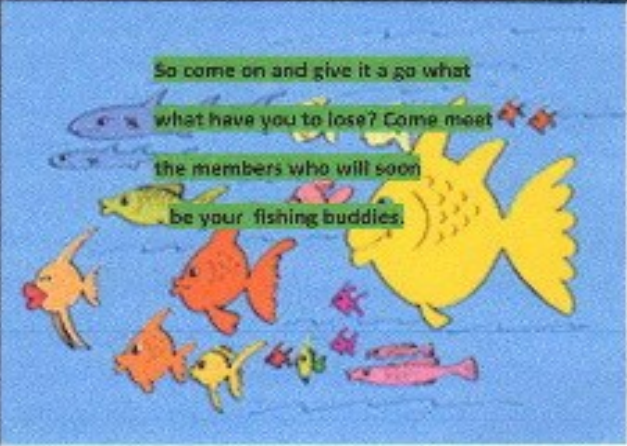
