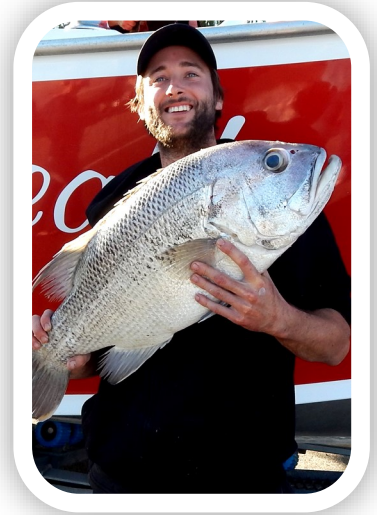

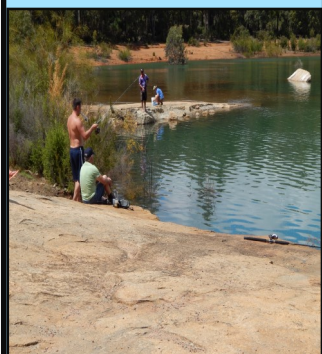
Lake Navarino 2014

Whiting with Tomato, Oregano & Pinenuts

Ingredients

150 g whiting fillets
2 tablespoons diced Tomatoes peeled & deseeded
1 tablespoon toasted Pine Nuts
1 teaspoon oregano leaves
2 tablespoons Extra Virgin Olive Oil
squeeze Lemon Juice
sea salt
cracked pepper

Method

In a saucepan heat the olive oil until warm, add in the tomato, pinenuts, oregano, lemon juice and salt and pepper.

Heat a frying pan or bbq and cook the whiting on one side until golden, then flip over and cook for a further minute (careful not to overcook).

Place the fish on a serving plate and spoon the tomato dressing over the fish.

Substitute fish – garfish, snapper, sardines, bream, scallops,

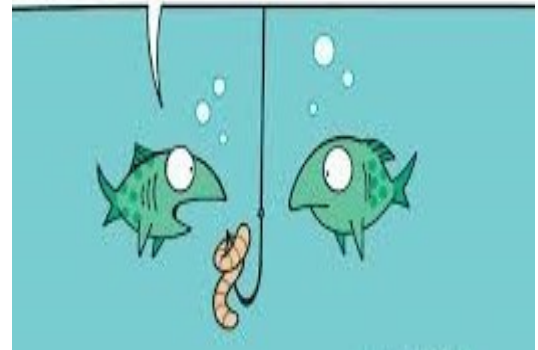

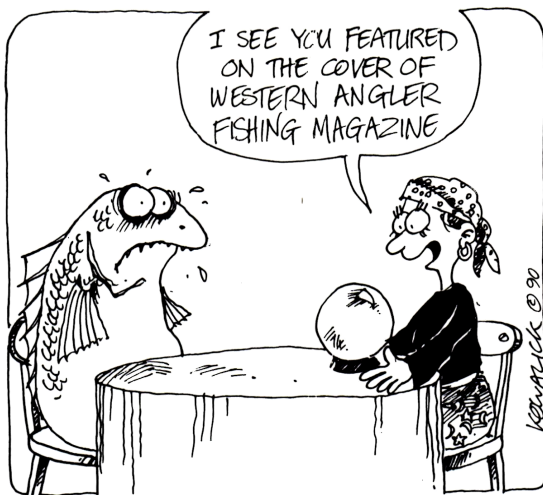

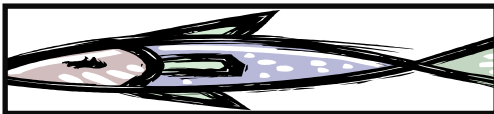
